From the Commodore by Shane Wallace

Hello Cypremort Yacht Club! Christmas AL-READY???? Yep, that is right; it's that time to be jolly and spread cheer about!

Last month, the club held its Semi-annual General Membership meeting, at which committee reports were made and an election was held to fill 4 slots on the board of directors. Those elected to 2 year terms were Edward Duhe, John Conner, Bill Butts and Karl Venable.

A special presentation was also made by Bill Butts regarding our insurance coverage and premium costs. The bottom line was that the club spends over \$12,000 a year for flood, fire, wind & hail and liability policies with differing amounts of coverage for each. Flood had the least amount of coverage at about \$129,000, with fire having

the most coverage at about \$350,000. It was also reported that the replacement cost on the clubhouse structure would be in the \$125 per square foot range, meaning about \$250,000 to replace our structure. A motion was introduced to keep insurance coverages at their present level and increase coverages rather than have a dues increase to cover additional cost. An amendment was then added to have the membership notified and their input solicited via the newsletter. Both the motion and amendment passed by vote of all members present. The board is open to readdressing this issue if there is sufficient interest. It would be most helpful if any interested member would send comments to me at either email address listed below within 15 days. Other than that, I really don't have much to

report at this time with activities at the club slowing down during these cold winter months. I suspect that members are getting down to their boats and getting some projects knocked out for next years sailing season.

I encourage you all to PLEASE come out to the club and enjoy our facilities. Bring as many friends as you want. Just remember that you are more than welcome to use our facilities for parties and other such functions with the understanding of the rules.
