Racing News by Butch Nolan

The next club race will take place on Saturday, May 9th. A skipper's meeting will be held at 10:00 AM with an 11:00 AM start. The course will be posted upstairs on the club board.

The Rosemary Lucas Cup race #4 scheduled for April 25th, was abandoned due to weather. CYC will have a make-up race on May 23rd to complete the series. Same time for skipper's meeting and race start.

In scoring boats for the series, if you miss a race, your finish position for that race is the number of boats registered for the whole series. If

you at least make the start, then your finish position for that race is only the number of boats for that particular race, plus one. So, if 3 boats race and you only start, then you would get a 4th place finish for that race, instead of the number of boats signed up for the series. This should give you some incentive to try to show up for all of the races.

The next "Round the Bay" race will take place on June 6th. Mark your calendars and plan to attend. Race will start at 9:30 AM and will be a minimum distance of 12 miles. A skipper's meeting will be held one

hour prior to race start. The final "Round the Bay" race will be held on August 15th.

Please plan on attending all of the functions planned for Saturday, May 9, 2015.
