Race #2 in the Daily Iberian Cup series was held on Saturday, September 8, with 5 boats competing in light wind over a relatively short 7 mile course. John & Julie Conner finished 1st and maintained a 110 second adjusted time advantage to edge out Brent & Mac Boulet who finished 2nd. Joe Gary claimed 3rd on adjusted time with Edward Duhe placing 4th.

Race #3 scheduled for September 22 was called due to weather.

Coming up next on the race calendar, Saturday, October 6 is the 3rd Round the Bay race. Skipper's meeting at 10:00 am with 11:00 am start.

The annual Sunfish "Sunsplash" Regatta is also scheduled for Saturday morning, Oct. 6. Skipper's meeting will be at 10:00 am. We would like to get more boats out for this race. CYC has Sunfish sailboats available for any members who would like to sail. I'd like to get a headcount, so please contact me by Wednesday night, Oct. 3, if you are interested.

Race #4 of fall series will be held on Oct. 13 and Race #5 on Oct. 27.

Sunfish Daysailer Adventure Cruise by Bill Whitehead

We're also planning to experiment with a Sunfish/ daysailer "adventure" cruise (daysailer = smaller sailboats without a cabin, or at least without a fixed keel, for example: Sunfish, Hobie Cats, Lasers, O'Day daysailer type boats) for one of the fall race weekends. These adventure cruises are popular with kayakers and we're adapting the idea to sailing—this is not a race. I'm suggesting Sunday, October 14. Plan to meet at

11:00 am at the clubhouse. Weather will determine the course, ideally a broad reach out for approximately 1 hour and then return. When we have the destination set (potentially a trip to the State Park, or out to circle Dry Reef, or explore West Cote Blanche Bay) we will launch, sail out to the destination and then sail back, exploring and having fun along the way. Participants should bring an ice chest/ water/snacks/sunscreen

and plan to be out on the water for about 3 hours (depending on the wind). Sunfish are available by reservation and I'm looking for a couple of volunteers with powerboats to provide "chase boat" assistance. If you would like to participate, please contact me by October 7.
