Junior Sunfish Program by Bill Whitehead

The 2016 Junior Sunfish Sailing Camp was held on July 15, 16 & 17, 2016. 21 juniors participated in this year's 3 day sailing camp with 9 Sunfish sailboats out on the Bay. While there were some interruptions from summer rain storms, the wind was generally cooperative and the juniors logged enough time out on the water and at the helm to compete several races on Sunday.

For the racing drill, each junior had an opportunity to skipper the sailboat around the triangular course twice. With 2 to 3 juniors per Sunfish, the skipper had the option to control both the tiller and mainsheet or to get crew to assist with the Al Rees promainsheet. vided the committee boat and introduced signal flags that designated the Sunfish one-design class, the start-

ing sequence and a flag to signal when to stop racing and return to the yacht club.

Juniors also received instruction in essential knot tying and volunteer Roberta Bienvenu devised a particularly effective, on-land demonstration of the points of sail using a fully rigged Sunfish on a launching dolly. The hull was spun around on the dolly to illustrate being in irons, pointing close to the wind, reaching and running.

CYC would like to thank all of the volunteers who made the camp successful and fun. We appreciate the assistance provided by several chase boats running continuously while the juniors were sailing, and Dan Snow who graciously volunteered his sloop to serve as a rest stop/ course mark/water park/ lunch picnic spot! Thanks

also to everyone who got wet, helped rig, launch and retrieve sunfish, and to those who worked to keep the juniors, coaches and volunteers hydrated and fed.

Thanks to all the parents for making it possible and the biggest thanks of all to the juniors who attended the camp.
