Continued: Youth Sunfish Sailing Camp

Volunteers are needed to assist with the camp. There are a variety of roles: on-water instructors, powerboat ("chase boats") operators & crew to support the sailors, ramp assistants to help move the boats in and out of the loading ramp, and lunch & refreshment support. Prior to the camp dates, an hour from a couple of people to stage the sunfish sailboats and get them ready for the camp.

Sunfish sailboats are 14 feet long. They have a simple rig: one sail, a mainsheet, daggerboard, and the rudder/tiller. Under sail, the Sunfish is responsive and perfect for learning the basics. **To volunteer please contact: Bill Whitehead at williamrwhitehead@gmail.com or 337-541-4238 Cell**
