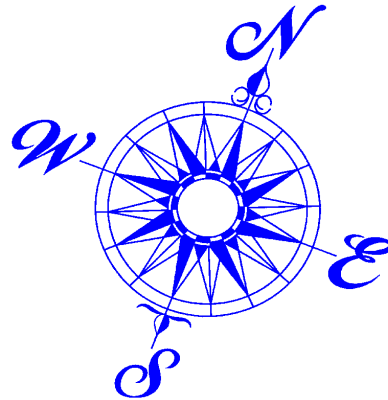

House and Grounds by Dan Snow

We have scheduled 2 work parties, one for June 19 and one for June 26, 2010. Starting at 9:00 A.M. on Saturday, June 19, 2010, we will pressure wash the deck and railings in preparation for painting on June 26. If you can spare the time, we would appreciate your assistance in this endeavor. Please bring long handled cleaning brushes, cleaning buckets, paint brushes, rollers, extensions, paint buckets, etc., to help with these projects.

Over the next few months, we will be ordering top soil to fill in along the west bulkhead in order to raise the level of the land up to the top of the bulkhead. This will help to drain water back away from the

bulkhead and prevent sink-holes from forming. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience our projects may cause, and ask for your indulgence while we get our Club in shape.

Your continued cooperation with the drinks in the refrigerator is appreciated. Remind your guests to pay for the drinks that they help themselves to from the refrigerator.

REMINDER: The refrigerator is for the storage of drinks, condiments and items for club functions. Members are welcome to use the refrigerator for the temporary storage of food items but are asked not to leave food items in the frig and to bring them home with you
