Our second quarter dues contains a note about the 2016 maintenance assessment which is \$120.00 payable either in one lump sum or 4 quarterly payments of \$30.00 each. The cost of replacing the bulkhead is far more than what our dues per year can cover. So please bear with us for the coming years because replacement of the bulkhead is necessary if we are to maintain our club and property. Once completed, we will need riprap to help protect the outside of our bulkhead wall. If any club member has contacts in demolition and

construction, please contact that person so we can possibly locate a source of broken concrete in need of disposal.

### Racing News by Bill Whitehead

The first two races in the spring Rosemary Lucas Cup series have been completed.

Race #1 on March 12 was delayed by rain. Four boats stated with three boats completing the course in a tight, rain-soaked finish separated by less than two minutes. Butch Nolan, Al Lilley and Edward Duhe were 1-2-3 on corrected time.

Seven boats started Race #2 on March 26 on an overcast morning with very light winds. Matt Geunther sailed to victory in a Hunter 170 sloop winning by a wide margin on both elapsed and corrected time. Competition for second place was closer with the next three boats finishing about two minutes apart. Mac Boulet was second, Butch Nolan was third, Joe Gary fourth and Edward Duhe fifth.

Race #3 in the series is April 9, race #4 is April 30 and race #5 is May 14. Skipper's meeting will be held at 10:00 A.M., with an 11:00 A.M. race start. A "round the bay" race is scheduled for April 16. While impressed by persistence and

patience on display during the first two races, I think all participants would be happy to have 5 to 10 mph winds and a ray of sun or two for the remaining races.
