Round the Bay race #4 will be held on Saturday, November 9, 2019. Skipper's meeting to be held at 10:00 am, with start of race at 11:00 am.


Make up race for the Fall Series will be held on Saturday, November 16, 2019. Skipper's meeting to be held at 10:00 am with start of race at 11:00 am.

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House and Grounds

We have been able to make some progress with regard to the repair of finger piers and wet slips. This work will probably be on hold until this coming spring. This will give us additional time to evaluate and prioritize the remainder of the project and hopefully we will be able to bring the project to its completion by the end of next year.

Thanks to all for your continuing cooperation with the drinks in the refrigerator. Please do not leave food items in the refrigerator. Our refrigerator is only for temporary storing of food and drink items. When you are finished cooking, etc., please take you items with you. When finished cooking on the stove or outdoor grill, please remember to

turn off the gas.

Also, someone used the indoor griddle in early October to cook what appeared to be two hamburger patties or small steaks and thereafter failed to clean and treat the griddle surface to keep it from rusting. As a result, when we went to use it for the last social on October 12, we found the griddle top to be dirty, rusted and pitted. This indoor griddle requires special cleaning and seasoning to keep it in proper condition. Instructions for the proper cleaning and seasoning of the griddle has been posted right above the griddle. We encourage members to use our facilities, but you are responsible to clean up properly after. If you are not willing to take

the time to properly clean and treat the surface of the griddle fin accordance with the instructions posted, then we respectfully request that you use the outdoor grill instead.
