### Racing News by Bill Whitehead

Rory Nolan won the 2017 Sunfish Sunsplash Regatta on October 7 scoring 3 wins in 3 races over a triangular course. Butch Nolan finished 2nd and Bill Whitehead finished 3rd. The wind was ideal at about 10 mp, kicked up by a system in the eastern Gulf. Al Rees Manned the Race Committee boat, set the course and handled the starting sequences flawlessly! Thanks Al!

Two boats competed in the Round-the-Bay race #5 also on October 7. This was a very close race with John & Julie Conner finishing the 8.3 mile course 1st, 63 seconds ahead of Mac & Brent Boulet. However, the Boulet's Pearson 365 won on corrected time.

The Daily Iberian Cup race #3 on October 14 drew 4 competitors on a beautiful Saturday morning with

winds from the NE at 11mph. The race was very tight over the 1st 2 legs with all 4 boats within hailing distance. The final upwind leg proved decisive. John & Julie Conner finished the 7 mile course 1st in both absolute and corrected time holding off Mac & Brent Bout who finished 2nd. Joe Gary placed 3rd and Al Lilley finished 4th.

The Daily Iberian Cup race #4 scheduled for October 28 was cancelled. Recall that a cold front had moved in with observed winds the night before gusting up to 33 mph. The brisk wind wasn't the most challenging component of conditions on Saturday morning-it was also low tide and water levels in the marina and in the bay were the lowest I have seen. Turns out most of the sailboats were resting on

their keels in the mud and it would not have been possible to motor out of the slip.


